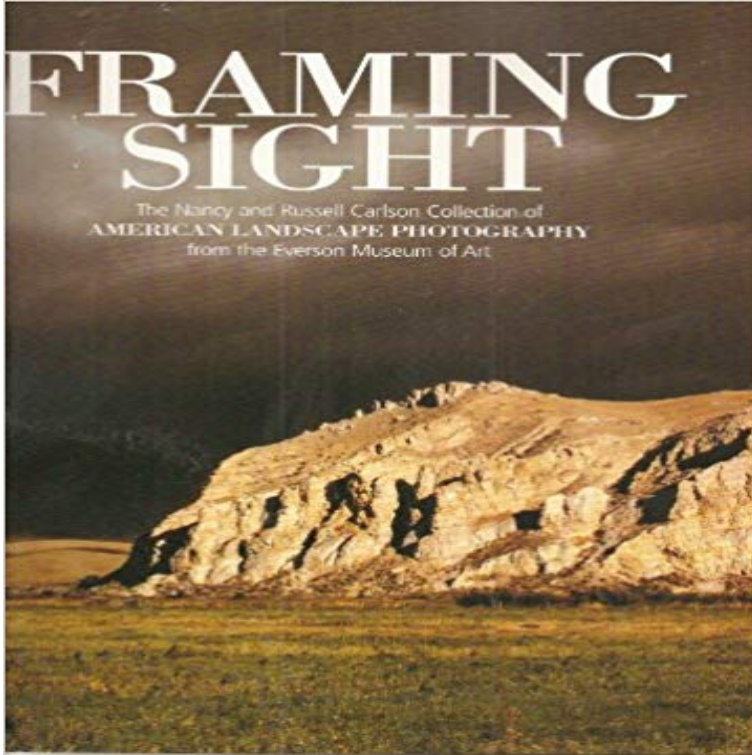


Framing Sight: the Nancy and Russell Carlson Collection of American Landscape Photography From the Everson Museum of Art
