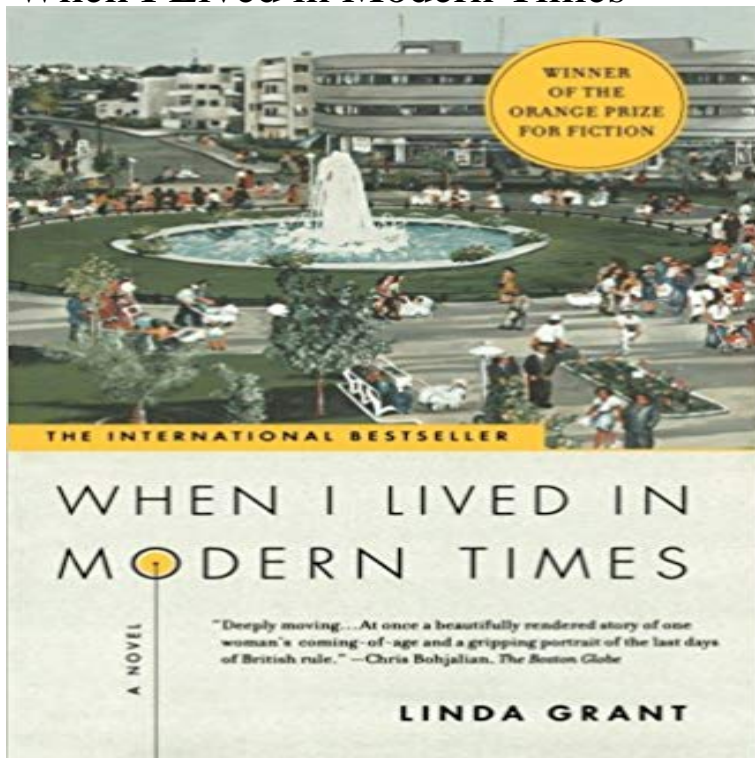


When I Lived in Modern Times
