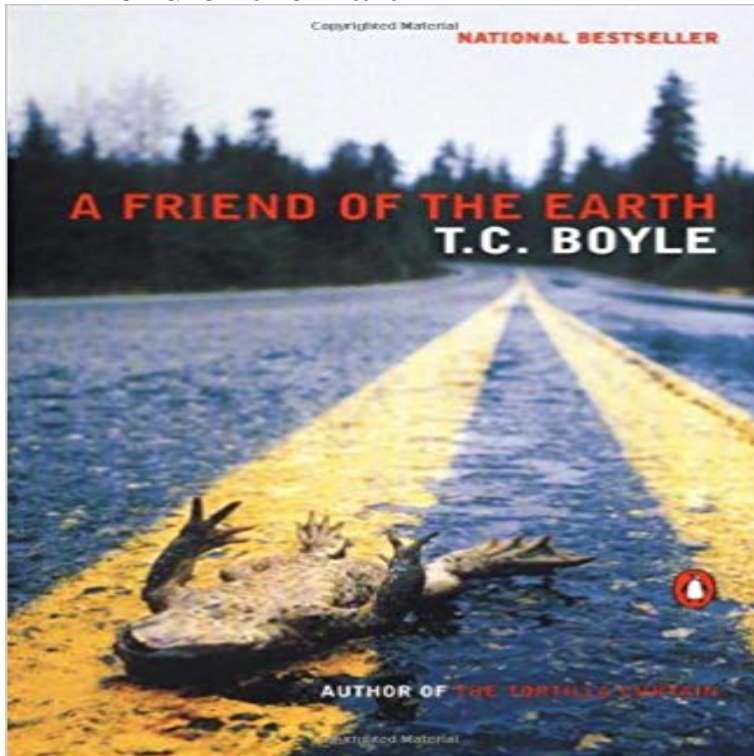


A Friend of the Earth
