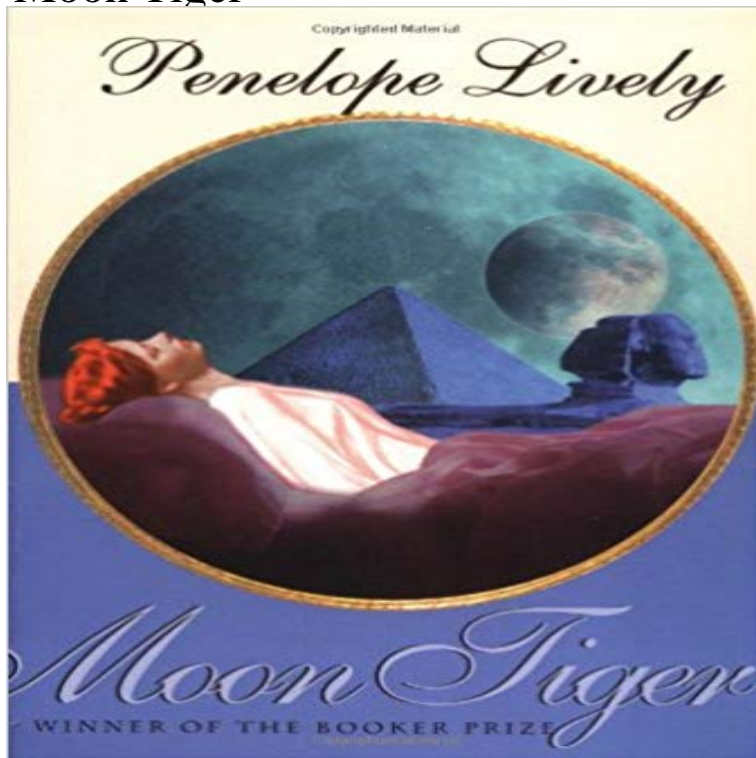


Moon Tiger
