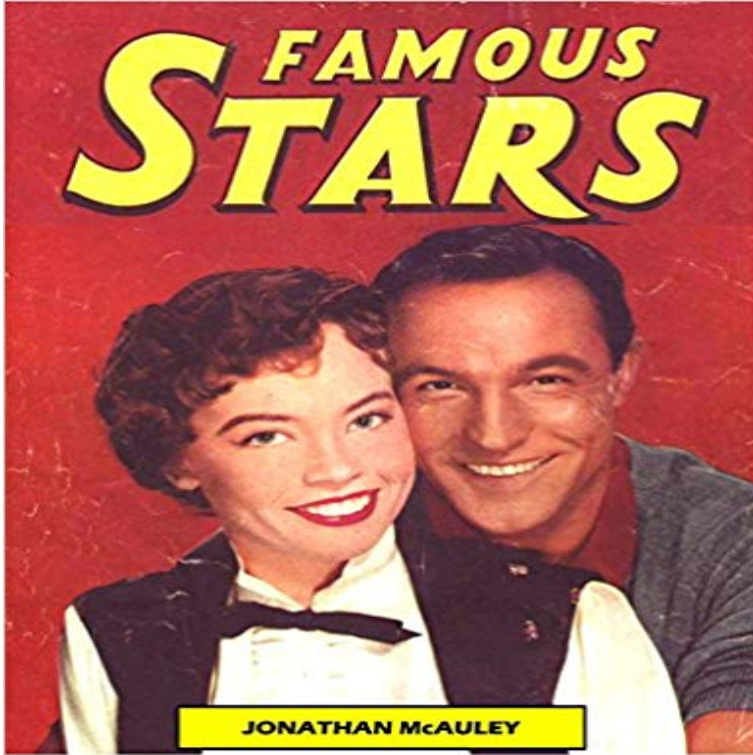

The 1950s saw the end of the Studio System, where most actors were under exclusive contract to one of the major studios (and where the major studios also owned their own chains of movie theaters) and the beginning of the Star System, where the movie actors (and also some directors) themselves were independent contractors, making movies for the highest bidding studios, often for little or no pay but for a percentage of the profits This book contains all 6 issues of FAMOUS STARS True Exciting Life Stories, illustrated in comic book format, of some of the most popular actors of that era.
