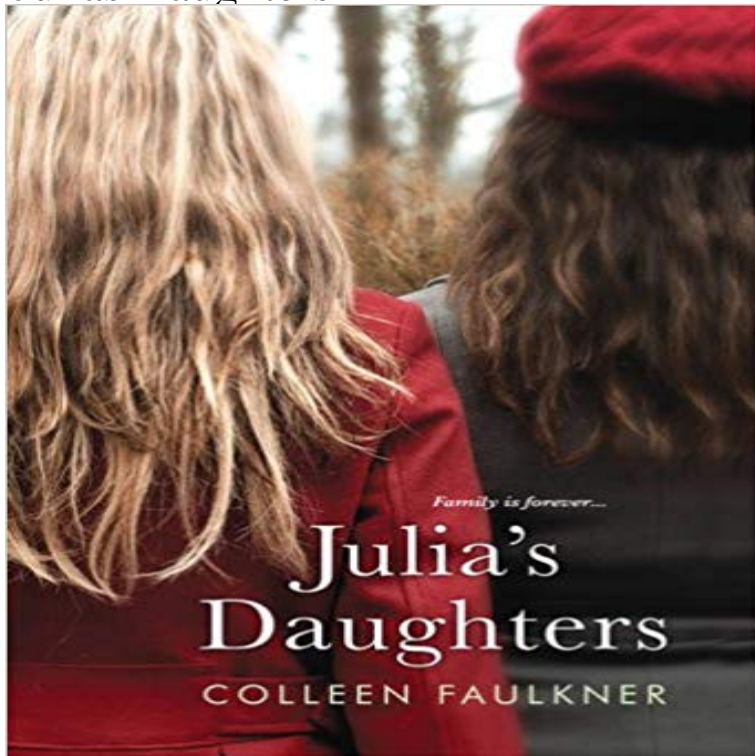


Julias Daughters
