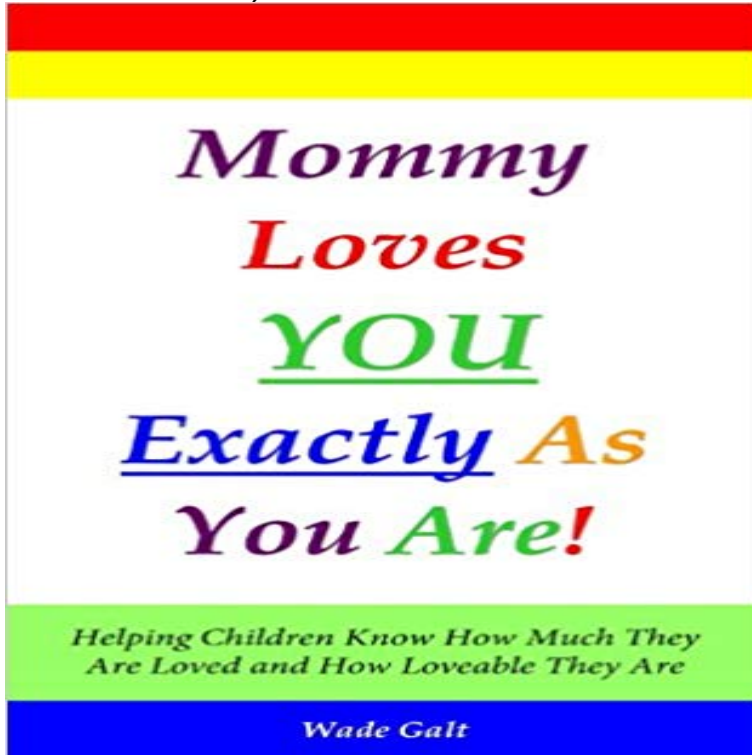


Mommy Loves You Exactly As You Are! (Parenting for Love and Self-Esteem)
