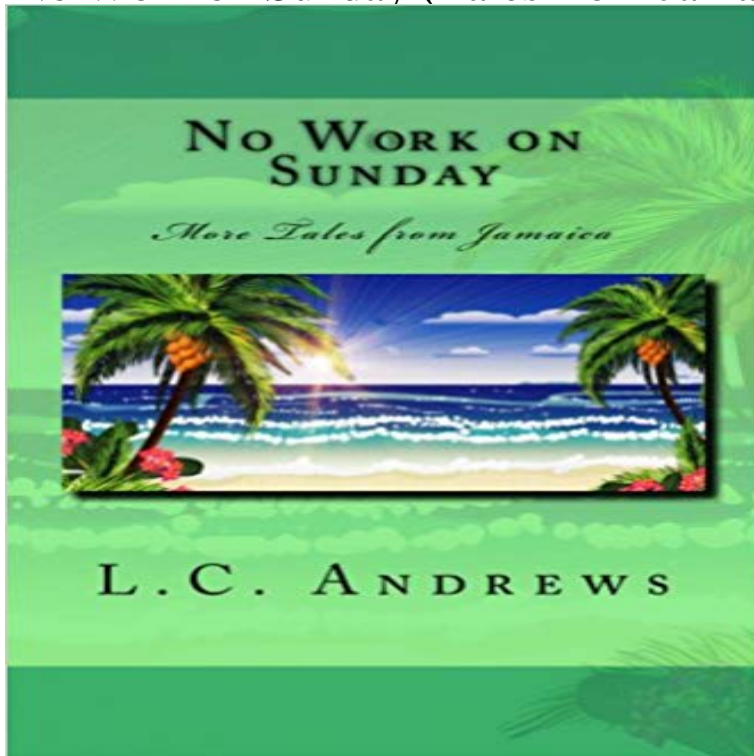


## No Work on Sunday (Tales from Jamaica Book 2)
