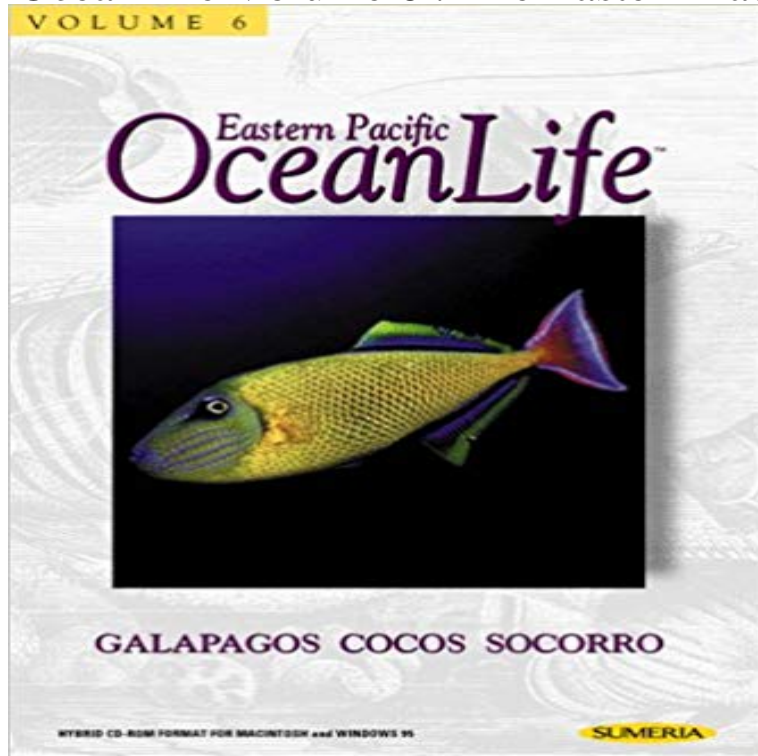


OceanLife Volume 6 : The Eastern Pacific
