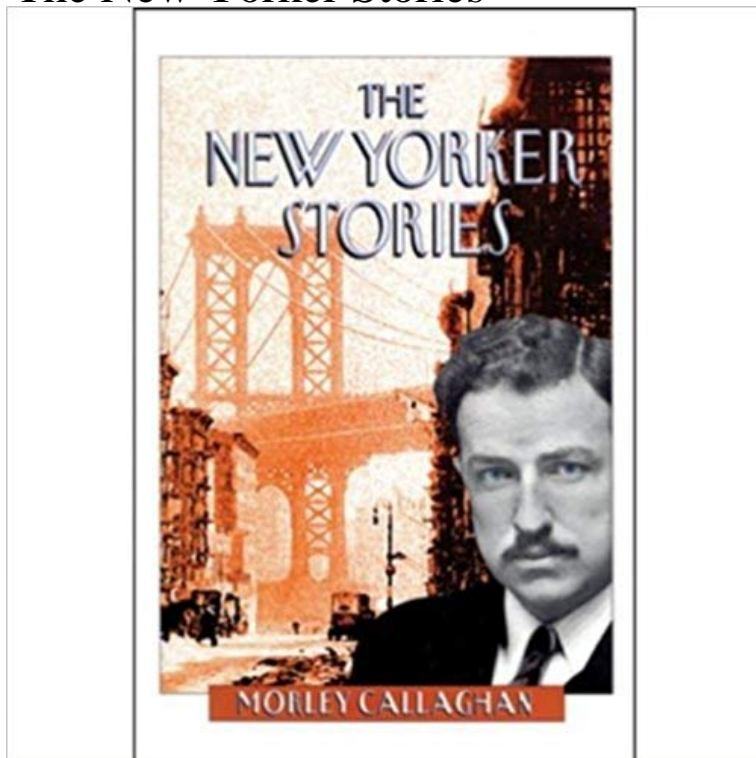


## The New Yorker Stories
