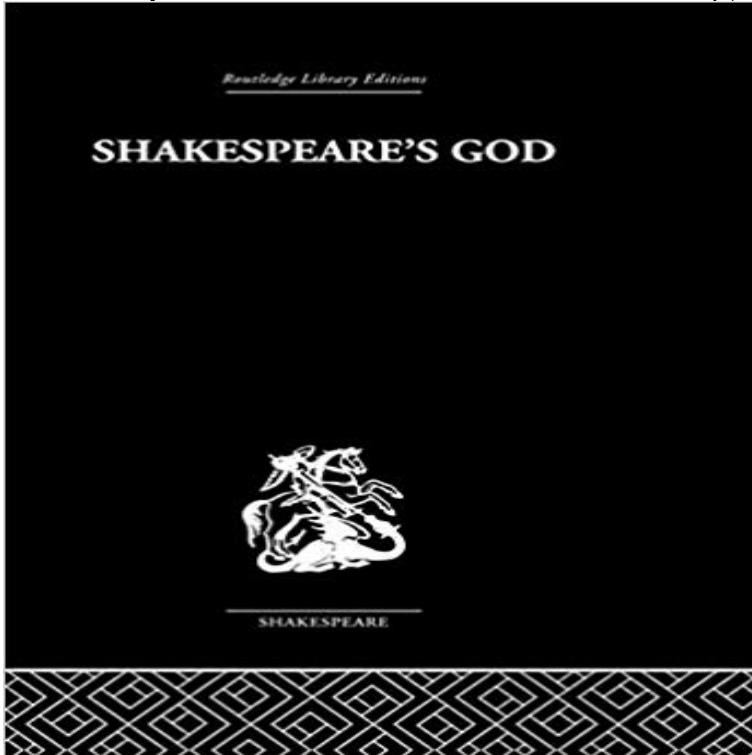


Shakespeares God: The Role of Religion in the Tragedies
