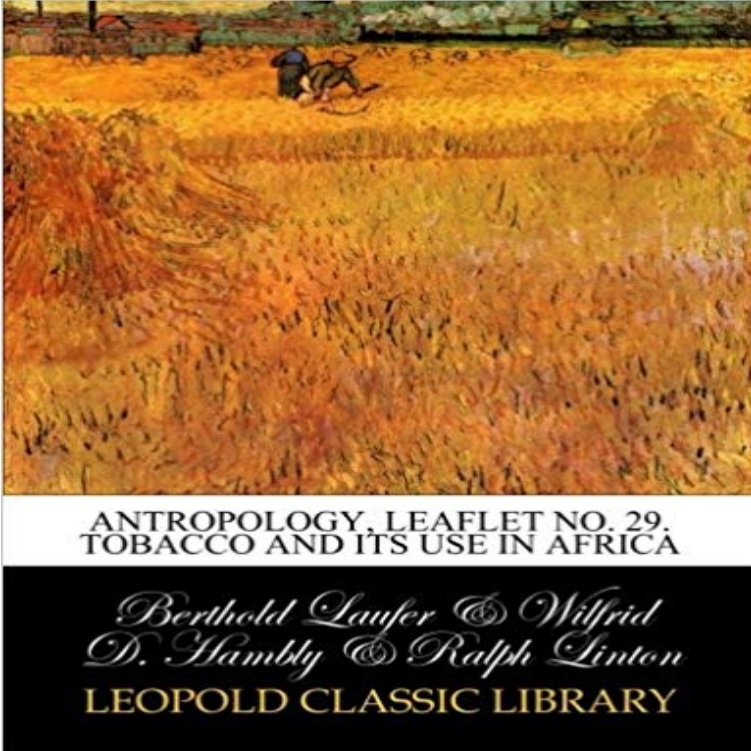


Antropology, leaflet No. 29. Tobacco and its use in Africa
