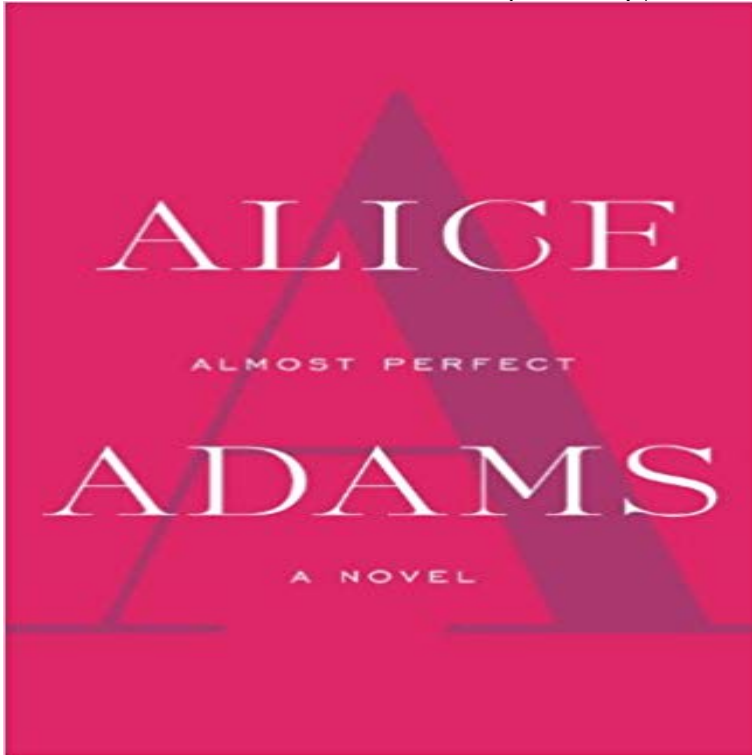


## Almost Perfect: A Novel (Vintage Contemporaries)
