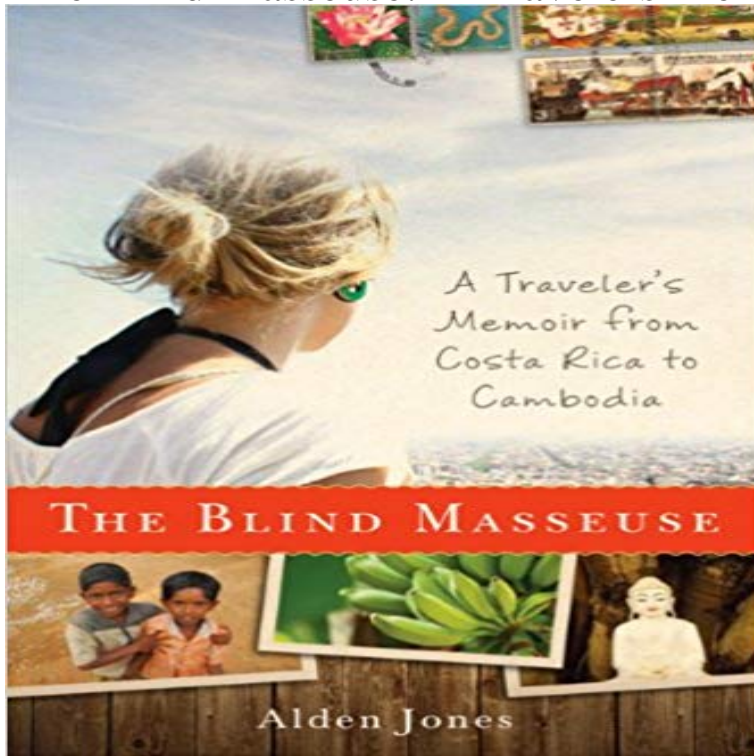


The Blind Masseuse: A Travelers Memoir from Costa Rica to Cambodia
