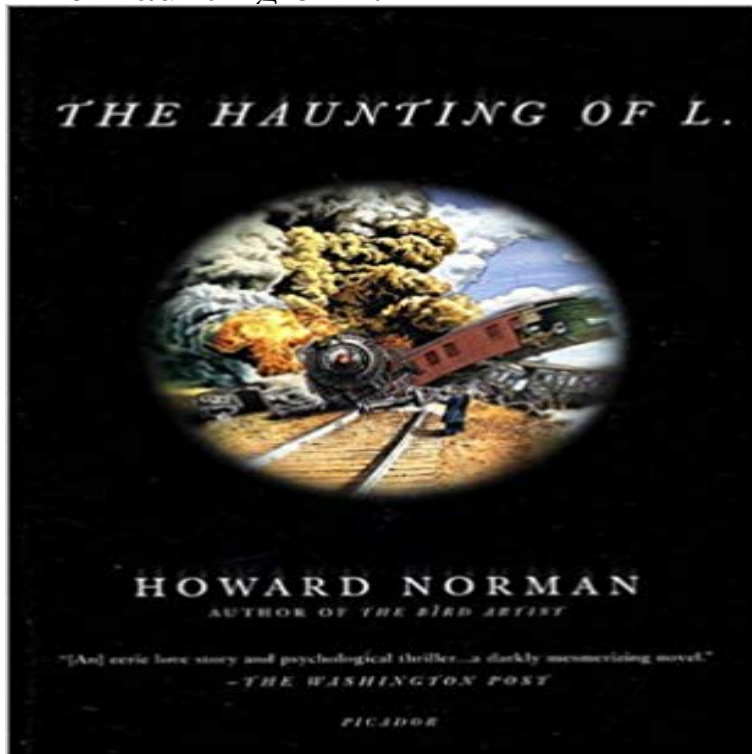


The Haunting of L.
