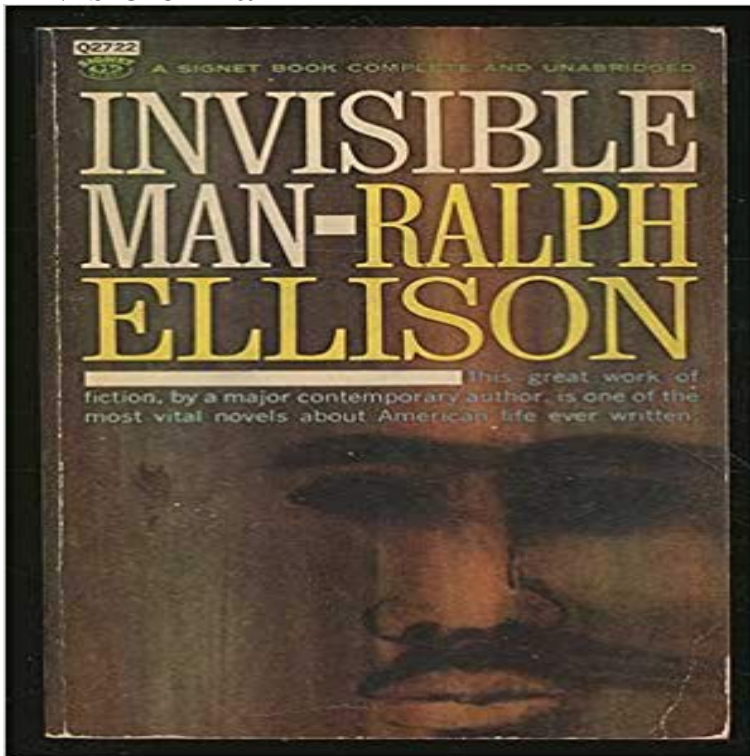


Invisible Man
