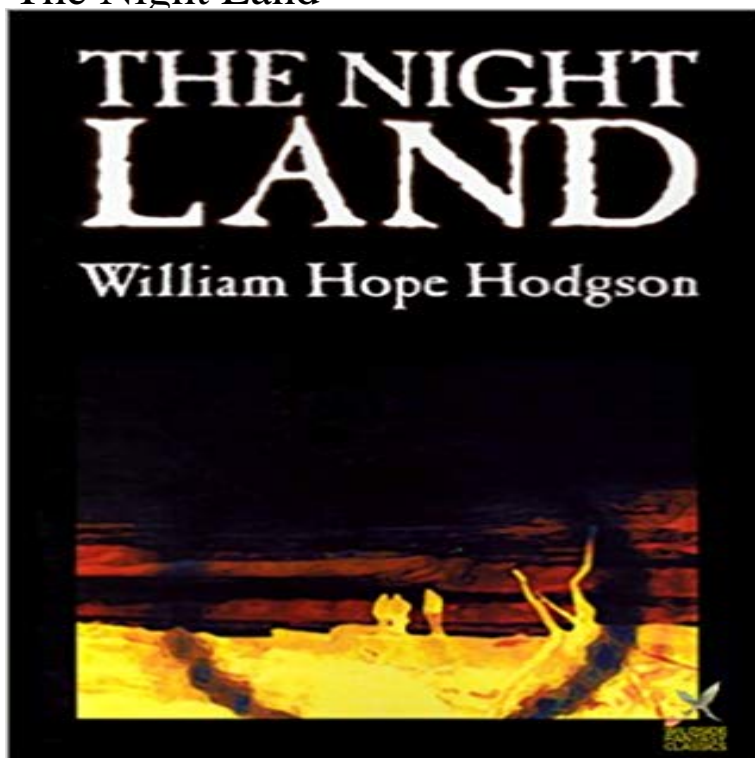


The Night Land
