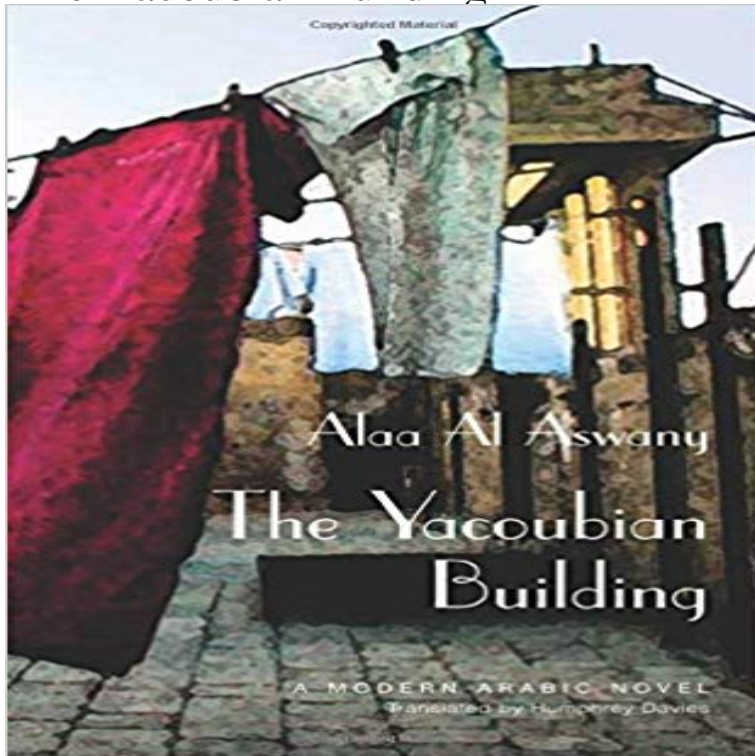


The Yacoubian Building
