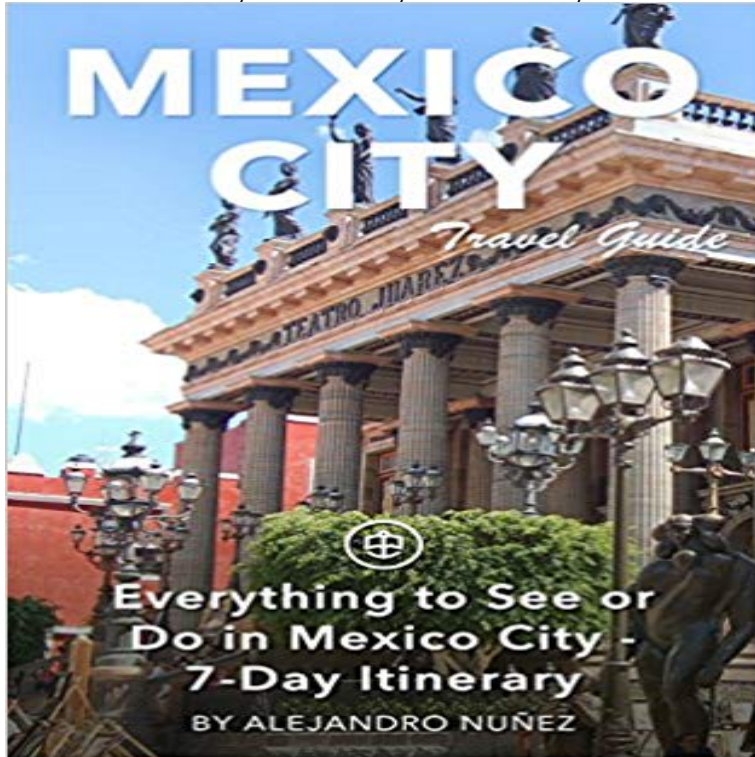


## Mexico City Travel Guide (Unanchor) - Everything to see or do in Mexico City - 7-Day Itinerary
